
## JUSTICE

# Fair treatment and due reward in accordance with values, standards or law.



Rule of conduct or procedure established by custom, agreement, or authority. Body of rules and principles governing the affairs of a community and enforced by a political authority.

### JUDGEMENT

# Act of judging or assessing a person or situation or event.

### PENALTY

#### Punishment imposed for a violation of law.

## TRIBUNAL

# Law court. The place where a session of court is held.

### OFFENCE

#### Violation or breach of a law, custom, rule, etc. Public wrong or crime.



Act committed in violation of law where the consequence of conviction by a court is punishment, especially where the punishment is a serious one such as imprisonment.

### INNOCENT

# Not guilty of a specific crime or offense; legally blameless.

## GUILTY

#### Responsible for a reprehensible act; culpable. Found to have violated a criminal law by a jury or judge.
